
For new installations, check for any electrical cables or pipe work (gas/water) in the vicinity of the intended mounting point for this product, before proceeding with the installation.







For advice on Suspension mounting or frame mounting your panel light please see the instruction provided with your chosen fixing kit.

Remove the ceiling tile currently occupying the space you intend the panel light to be fitted.

! You must ensure that no insulation material is sat directly on top of the panel light !




Offer the panel light up to the hole in the ceiling. You can now connect the panel to the power supply. (*see page 4*)




After you have connected the panel light to the power supply, raise it up into the wall tile ceiling frame and let it fall into position ensuring that it is sat firmly in the ceiling frame all the way around.

Connect the panel to the driver by pushing the connecting pieces on both products together and then twist the driver connector as shown to secure.



Connect the driver cable into your lighting ring main.

AC N = Neutral (Blue) AC L = Live (Brown)

The panel is now ready for use.

- This product is covered by the standard indoor Biard 5 limited year warranty for any manufacturing faults.
